WHICH IS MORE IMPOPRTANT?

Jesus went so far as to call some people "hypocrites" (Mark 7:6) and explained that what comes from the inside of an individual is what "defiles" him, not the other way around (Mark 7:14-23). If we're not careful, we can become so absorbed with looking good on the outside, that we forget what really counts. In fact, when we get to the place where we think "we've arrived," we may become proud of ourselves and judgmental toward others. Harboring bitterness, clinging to critical attitudes, and thinking too highly of ourselves are the kind of defiling things that make us guilty of Jesus' charge of being a "hypocrite." The point is this: It's the things on the inside of our heart — our thoughts and attitudes that really matter to the Lord 2 Corinthians 10:5:

THANKSGIVING, WHERE TO FIND IT?

Samuel Johnson said, "Gratitude is a fruit of great cultivation. You do not find it among gross people." First Thessalonians 5:18 sums it up: "In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." Gratitude is not always easy, and it is not the world's way to acknowledge and thank God. But it is the Lord's will. Gross people don't thank God in even the best of circumstances. But God's people always do, even in the worst. If we are in Christ we always have reason to thank God!

Don't Be Foolish"

The Lord included in His "Sermon on the Mount" a warning that causes on to ponder. He taught His followers to not call anyone a fool or he would be in danger of hell fire (Matt. 5:22). Why such a severe penalty for simply calling someone a fool?

The usual definition of "fool" is "one deficient in intellect or judgment." We run into to those quite regularly! "The fool hath said in his heart,

'There is no God'" (Ps. 14:1). Solomon with "wisdom" gave a lengthy discourse in his Proverbs on the matter. "Fools despise wisdom" (1:7); "The way of a fool is right in his own eyes; but he that hearkeneth to counsel is wise" (12:15); "Folly of fools is deceit...Fools make a mock at sin" (14:8-9); The lips of the foolish does not disperse knowledge (15:7); "The mouth of fools feedeth on foolishness" (15:14).

"And a highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called the way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the way faring men, though fools, shall not err therein" (Is. 35:8).

The Pharisees were chastised by the Lord and called "fools" because they criticized and judged the hearts of men by what they observed outwardly (Lk. 11:37-40). The rich man, who built bigger barns to amass worldly goods but was not "rich" toward God, was called a fool by the Lord and told that his soul would be required of him the very same night (Lk. 12:20). Finally, we can conclude that the real fool is the one who denies God and resists his Word. We may feel too refined to be considered a fool, but a careful examination of our personal life may reveal more than what we would like to acknowledge about ourselves.
