"GENUINE"

The Word of Jehovah teaches that we are to be genuine in our faith. "Let love be without hypocrisy" (Rom.12:9, ASV). "Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart" (1 Pet.1:22, ESV). "The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith" (1 Tim.1:5). "I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love" (2 Cor.8:8). However, being authentic and sincere in our walk with the Lord has never been a license to continue in sin. Those who lay claim to being authentic often times are doing nothing more than cheapening the grace of God! Being an authentic Christian means that I have become dead to sin, and no longer seek to live therein. "What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein" (Rom.6:1-2). God gives grace so that we may come out of our sins, not so that we may continue in them! "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you" (2 Cor.6:17). Authentic Christianity demands repentance, not rebellion; reformation, not rationalization. To claim to follow Christ, yet refuse to give up sin, is as disingenuous and hypocritical as you can get!
