1. Fill your life With Good. Clean out the trash and fill your life with good thought and good deeds. **Philippians 4:8-9-** Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable-if anything is excellent or praiseworthy think about such things, Whatever you learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me-put it into practice and the God of peace will be with you. 2. Learn to Laugh and Learn to Cry. Romans 12:12-18- Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who morn. Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low positions. Do not be conceited. Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. 3. Learn to Practice the, "Happiness Habit." Learn to smile and the world will smile with you. Philippians 4:4-5- Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: *Rejoice!! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.* **4. Learn to fear** Nothing or No One. Is Baptism Important?

Many people in the denominational world say that baptism has little or nothing to do with our salvation, It is baptism however, that puts us into Christ so that we can be saved. Galatians 3:27 says, "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ." Baptism is the only way a person can get into Christ. The preposition into indicates a change of relationship. You can search from the front to the back of your Bible, and you will find no other way to get into Christ except by being baptized into Christ. What is the advantage of being baptized into Christ. Ephesians 1:3 says, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in heavenly places in Christ." This verse tells us that every spiritual blessing is located in Christ. Only those who are in Christ can enjoy these spiritual blessings. We read in 2 Corinthians 5:17, "Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation: old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new." If one is in Christ, he has become a new creation. This is how we are born again. The Apostle Paul says in 2 Timothy 2:10, "Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory." Here we see that salvation is located in Christ, and for one to be eligible for salvation, he must be in Christ. It will be a horrible thing for a person, who thinks he is saved, when he stands before the Lord on the Day of Judgment, if he is still outside of Christ. Tragically, many die out of Christ having no spiritual security. Our only hope of going to Heaven is to obey Christ. Jesus taught, "If you love me you will keep my commandments". John 14:23
