RENEE WHITLEY has a case of the shingles. WAYNE HOLLAND, brother of Millie Baur, underwent a heart cath and surgery last week.


JASON GIBSON, the young soldier, is still recovering at Walter Reed hospital from his wounds sustained in Afghanistan.
