## IS CURSING A SIN?

“My friend and I were having a conversation the other day on whether or not cursing is a sin. He said that curse words were made to mean what they do by society. I was wondering if there is any biblical information on this topic and if it is sinful.”

### What Do The Inspired Scriptures Say?

Cursing (swearing, cussing, profanity) is certainly a sin according to the inspired Scriptures, no matter what a society says or accepts. The inspired apostle Paul tells us to “Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers” (Ephesians 4:29). We are again warned by Paul to “put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth” (Colossians 3:8). In the Greek language, the phrase, “filthy communication” means foul speaking, low and obscene speech. In his letter, James declares that cursing should not come out of our mouth (James 3:10). He admonishes us further in James 4:11, not so much as to speak evil of another brother. For an example, Peter assured the Lord that he would “never fall away” from following him (Matthew 26:33 – ESV). Yet, just a few short hours later, this same apostle “denied with an oath” that he even knew Jesus (Matthew 26:72). The inspired record says that he even began to “curse and to swear”, reinforcing his denials of Jesus (Matthew 26:74). If the best of men were guilty of occasional lapses with regard to cursing and swearing, we must be constantly on guard that we do not sin even more grievously.

### Conclusion

In Colossians 4:6, the apostle Paul tells us to, “Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.” Our speech should contain wholesome, pure, kind, and beneficial words. Words that encourage and build up a person, instead of tearing them down (Proverbs 16:23; Proverbs 25:11; cf).

## GOD'S CHILDREN MUST EXCELL

Someone noted this similarity between playing bagpipes and throwing a javelin blindfolded, “you don’t have to be good to get everyone’s attention!” What kind of person gets your attention? The Bible tells us the kind of person kings and other prominent people are searching for in proverbs 22: 9, “Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown men.” Cream rises to the top, and excellence in work and character stands out like a diamond in the mud. A lack of excellence in our work for God will not please Him. Jeremiah 48:10 reveals the seriousness of serving God in a shoddy and less than excellent way: “A curse on him who is lax in doing the Lord’s work” (NIV). The New American Standard Bible renders this verse, “Cursed be the one who does the LORD’S work negligently.” Every Christian at every position of service to God - can serve well, or we can serve poorly. We can excel, or we can be lax and negligent.

Mark 7: 34 says about Jesus, “He has done all things well,” revealing that Jesus was committed to excellence in His service to God and to us. A Lord who did His best for us deserves the best we can do for Him. A church cannot excel unless the members who make it up are devoted to excellence. How excellent are you in living, loving, giving, forgiving, attending, worship, praying, teaching, and serving?

Everyone has a bad day now and then. Some people have so many, they walk around like Eeyore from Winnie the Pooh: head hung low, always thinking about how bad things are, wondering how bad things are going to get.

Remember, this is a man who: received 39 stripes from his Jewish brethren, three times was beaten with rods, stoned, and shipwrecked three times.

This is a man who said he faced perils of water, robbers, countrymen, heathens, cities, wilderness, sea,

false brethren, pain, hunger, thirst, cold, nakedness, not

to mention the dozens of little things that happened to

him every day (2 Cor. 11:24-28).
