Compromising The Truth Of God's Word

The truth of God's word has been severely compromised down through the ages by man. Man continues to compromise it today. There are those, "who exchange the truth of God for a lie" (Romans 1:25). And "there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ" (Galatians 1:7). One of the reasons man compromises God's word is he is ashamed of it. But Jesus says, "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels" (Mark 8:38). If Jesus is ashamed of us we will be lost. Paul says, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes" (Romans 1:16). We compromise the truth when we hold back and fail to teach and preach all of God's word. Paul tells the Ephesian elders, "Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men. For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God" (Acts 20:26-27). We will be held accountable when we fail to teach the whole counsel of God. We are warned by God, "When I say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die', and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life, that same wicked man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood will I require at your hand" (Ezekiel 3:18). Today there are certain things in God's word that people will not teach because they are afraid they might offend someone. They are more afraid of offending people than offending God. If we fail to speak up and teach and preach the whole counsel of God, God will hold us responsible and we will most likely be lost

WHEN I SURVEY THE WONDROUS CROSS

We have read many times from the Bible about the cross of Christ. Many sermons have been preached about His crucifixion. In fact, the theme of New Testament preaching was Jesus Christ and Him crucified (Acts 2:22-36; 1 Corinthians 1:17-25). A great song of old is "When I Survey The Wondrous Cross". As we think about His cross, as we in our minds go back to Calvary, what do we see?

When we survey the cross of Christ, we see the **REALITY OF SIN**. It was sin that put Christ on that cross at Calvary. Notice a few of the verses in the Bible that affirm such: *"For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."* (2 Corinthians 5:21); *"Who was delivered for our offenses, and was raised again for our justification."* (Romans 4:25); *"Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree..."* (1 Peter 2:24); *"So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many..."* (Hebrews 9:28).

There would have been no need for the cross of Christ if there had been no sin. Christ was at Calvary, going through pain and agony, because of our sins. At the cross of Christ we see the reality of sin.

When we survey the cross of Christ we also see the **REMEDY FOR SIN**. His death had a purpose, had meaning. The Remedy was and is Jesus blood. We reach his blood in baptism. Romans 6:1-6. Have you applied the blood of our Saviour to your life that you might be cleansed of your sins and have the hope of life eternal?
