#### **BIBLICAL AUTHORITY**

The basic and fundamental problem in churches and religious institutions today is a lack of respect for God's Biblical authority. In other words, people don't want to listen to what the Bible has to say on certain matters, they would rather use their own opinions. We are chosen by God to be builders in His kingdom (1 Pet. 2:5). We are builders and thus we must build on God's blueprint. This does not mean we can change God's blueprint to fit our lifestyles and opinions, instead we follow the blueprint that has already been laid and we continue the good work that has already been established in Christ's church. Instead of building on God's blueprint, many churches and Christians today add to God's blueprint. It's important to understand the difference. "Building on God's blueprint" is continuing with the teachings of the Chief Cornerstone (1 Pet. 2:6). It means that we are building upon the foundation that Jesus Christ and the Apostles built. It means that we are following the same blueprint that God gave them to continue building the kingdom of Christ. "Adding to God's blueprint" means that we have decided, on our own accord, that God's blueprint isn't good enough and so we will make changes so it can fit my lifestyle. Do you know what happens to a house that is built and measurements are off by just a few inches? It can collapse! We should beware of changing God's blueprint. God has given us everything we need. God has given us *His* words to live by. We should at all time in worship or otherwise respect the authority of Jesus Christ our Lord. Someday we will give account of our respect or lack of it when we stand before our maker. Do you respect Bible authority? Without it all else fails and our efforts are in vain. DAN
