"ARE YOU LISTENING"

How do we participate in a sermon? We listen carefully and we think about what is being said. We think about whether the passages used are being applied correctly. We think about how it applies to us, individually, as families, and as a congregation. Many bring pen and paper, making notes to keep better focused. Some use wide-margin Bibles so they can make notes alongside passages. This is not a time for being distracted by audience noise or movement, of thoughts about lunch, or matters at home or work. It is a time for God's word, a lamp unto our feet and a guide unto our path. A simple comparison may help us: how do we properly take the Lord's Supper? Most of us say that we put away the cares of everyday life and focus on the Lord and His sacrifice for our sins. This same sort of focus is the answer to dealing with sermons. The idea of falling asleep during the bread and cup are passed... We get out of invest of ourselves the greater blessings we will receive, not from "the sermon," that's the wrong way to think of it, but of the study of God's word. "Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified, just as it is with you" 2 Thessalonians 3:1. Keep listening. DAN




From Dan's desk:

"GOD IS A ALL POWERFUL GOD"

When Joshua was commissioned to lead the people into Canaan, he had a lot to worry about. What if the people rebel? After all, they had before. What if they didn't respect him? They had respected Moses, but he was dead. What if he made wrong decisions and made God angry? Joshua had seen that happen many times. God went to extraordinary lengths to make sure Joshua had the courage to lead the people. (Joshua 1:2-9) "Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go. "God's promise was that Joshua could accomplish all that he was sent to do. But where was the proof? How could Joshua know that he would succeed? "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismaved, for YHWH your God is with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9) Joshua could succeed because God had commanded him. Similarly, another leader named Gideon was sent to deliver the people. This man was predisposed to be afraid, given the time and circumstances under which he lived. (Judges 6:11-16) Gideon had every excuse in the book. His tribe was too small, he was too young, the Midianites were too large. God's response, however, was to have courage. "Go in this your strength and deliver Israel from the hand of Midian. Have I not sent you?" (Judges 6:14) When it seemed like God's people would never again have success as a nation, God promised them deliverance. Being in Babylonian captivity would seem like the end of the road, but God promised that He would deliver them and return a remnant to Jerusalem, and He did. Our God is powerful. DAN
