#### WHO ARE WE?

"Inquisitive minds want to know," so we are told. In a world with a huge variety of religions and in a "church" world that offers a huge variety of denominational churches, inquisitive minds that do actually want to know may become minds that are confused. In the hope of shedding some light, we offer a bit of information designed to let you know what we, the church of Christ (at this congregation.) are all about. There are things we share in common with other churches, but there are also things that clearly distinguish us from any other religion on earth. One distinguishing mark is our allegiance to the Bible as the word of the Living God. First and foremost, this congregation is committed to practicing and preaching only those things we find authorized in the New Testament. We believe having authority is essential (Col. 3:17; Rom. 15:18; Matt. 28:18-19). Second, our worship is, to the best of our ability, a replica of that which the New Testament teaches. As we assemble to take the Lord's Supper (Acts 2:42; 20:7) we also pray together (1 Cor. 14:15-16), we give of our means to support the work of the church (1 Cor. 16:1-4), we teach the sacred word (1 Thess. 5:27) and sing praises to God (Eph. 5:19). Third, our work consists of causing the gospel to be preached (Phil. 1:5), relief of the needy for whom the church is responsible (Acts 6:1-6; 1 Tim. 5:16), and edification (Eph. 4:12,16). We reject radicalism as well as liberalism. We seek to deviate neither to the left nor to the right, "from any of the words (*God*) commands." DAN

## 6.8 Hours A Day

A while back I read that children of school age view television approximately 6.8 hours a day, every day! That doesn't include TV they watch at school. Home time is divided between TV viewing and video games. You may be saying, "My children don't spend that much time watching the tube." But check some time.

The degree of time watching TV is not as much a problem as what we watch and hear on TV. Legislators, philosophers, Hollywood moguls, and educators have been debating the adverse (or good) effect television has on, not just youngsters, but all of us. "Evil begets evil; good begets good."

Television is with us all the time. Any time you turn it on you see programs produced by the movie, news and entertainment industry. What we see is a lot of violence, murder, sexual perversion, crime, sin, war and maybe (seldom) a good story of human interest and good entertainment. Why? The television industry knows what sells, what people want to see, and they provide plenty of it. To them, what sells is more important than content.

Watch television and you see advertisements that often are questionable in content. Some TV ads should be rated. Have you ever watched your children during a cartoon? At a very early age, they will lose some attention to the cartoon itself, but as soon as an advertisement comes on, their attention instantly perks up.

This is not to say all television programs are sinful, but parents must be careful that too much TV doesn't occupy the attention of our children and ourselves. Study this good resolve: "I will set before my eyes no vile thing" (Ps 101:3) NIV
