The deceit of Ananias and Sapphira outwardly toward the brethren was evil. But their crime was in their heart against God. The lesson is simple. God will receive nothing less than complete surrender to him. Submit wholly to Christ through faith and cease deceiving your own heart. God will not be mocked. People do what they want to do. They do what they do freely without being forced to do so. People were not forced to crucify Christ. Pilate was said to have, "Delivered Jesus to their will." While they were acting freely and uncoerced, they were doing neither more nor less than "Whatsoever Thy hand and Thy counsel determined before to be done." Men do precisely what they want, and God exercises absolute sovereignty over men's, but we make choices that are often not in harmony with God's Will. Their hearts were wrong. IS YOURS?

STRAIT IS THE GAIT & NAR-ROW THE WAY

"Enter ye in at the strait gate...Strait is the gate and narrow is the way which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." "Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek enter in, and shall not be able" (Matthew 7:13; Luke 13:24The words above were spoken by the Lord Jesus Christ, And He said in another place, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). Since then, HE is the "Strait gate," "the narrow way," and the "life:" and since HE is received through simple faith and trust (Acts 10:43; 16:30,31; Rom. 10:1-17; John 3:14-16, 36), WHY is the entrance and way of life described as being so strait, so narrow, so compressed, so difficult? Is it because men are so sinful and their sins so numerous that, with such a load, they cannot squeeze into the kingdom of God? No, that is not the difficulty. The most wicked and vile sinner who ever lived may enter the "strait gate" but they must come on the terms of Jesus. We must repent of our sins, Luke 13:3-5 and be baptized Mark 16:15-16, to get on the "strait and narrow". Many have done that recently here at Crockett Rd.
