FALSE DOCTRINE

As long as the world lasts there will always be false doctrine taught. 2 Peter 2:1-2 says, "But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false prophets among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed." Notice that false doctrine is brought in secretly in a way that people are not aware of it. As this destructive doctrine is taught, the truth of God's word is evil spoken of and belittled. But how do we recognize false doctrine so we can protect ourselves against it? 1 John 4:1 says, "Beloved believe not every spirit, but test the spirits whether they be of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world." We are told to test them just as the Bereans did in Acts 17:11, 'They...searched the scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so." If we will only study God's word daily so "That we should no longer be children tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting" (Ephesians 4:14). "BE AN OVERCOMER"

Jesus taught that we can be overcomers. The overcomers in Ephesus, the loveless church, were promised to "eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God." (2:7). The overcomers in Smyrna, the persecuted church, were told that they wouldn't be hurt by the second death (2:11). The overcomers in Pergamos, the compromising church, were told they would be given hidden manna to eat, a white stone, and a brand new name (2:17). The overcomers in Thyatira, the corrupt church, were promised power over the nations (2:26). The overcomers in Sardis, the dead church, would be given white garments and a name that wouldn't be blotted out of the Father's book of life (3:5). The overcomers in Philadelphia, the faithful church, would receive a pillar in the temple of God and be given the New Name (3:12). And finally, the overcomers in Laodicea, the lukewarm church, were promised that they would sit with Jesus on the throne (3:21). Notice two things: first, the beauty of the promises to those who are faithful even in the face of death. Second, notice that Jesus fully expected that in every church and in any situation—even in the dead and loveless churches, we could overcome. I find great comfort in these words and hope that you will too. Let's be overcomers together! With God's help (Phil 4:13) great things happen. DAN
