"NOW THIS IS REAL HOPE"

W.E. Vine's Bible Dictionary gives this definition of the word HOPE. "In the New Testament, hope is a favorable and confident expectation. It has to do with the unseen and the future" (Romans 8:24-25). Hope describes (a) the happy anticipation of good (the most frequent significance) (Titus 1:2, I Peter 1:21), (b) the ground upon which the hope is based, (Acts 16:19, Colossians 1:27) "Christ in you, the hope of glory," and (c) the object upon which the hope is fixed" (I Timothy 1:1). We often use the word HOPE to indicate a doubt. "I hope it rains again this weekend." Using the word in such a way does not indicate assurance, but a desire that may or may not be fulfilled. HOPE as used in God's word is linked to faith and assurance. God makes promises. Faith causes us to trust God's promises. Hope is the expectation based of faith that we will see the promises of God fulfilled. God has promised that Jesus Christ will return. By faith, we accept that promise with full assurance. Therefore the return of Christ is called our "blessed hope" (Titus 2:13). This assurance of faith and hope gives us a boldness that makes us "not ashamed" (Romans 5:5). Paul writes" Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us" (Romans 5:1-5). Isn't this the hope that we all want and desire? It is a hope that is real and the thing that gives us courage to go on through the trials and difficulties of this life.

ARE YOU A SPIRIT

REFRESHER?"

What a blessing for Paul to have a friend like Onesiphorus who gave comfort to him. The expression used in II Timothy to describe this comfort is "he oft refreshed me." Vine's Dictionary of New Testament Words defines the word "refresh" in this manner: "to give intermission from labor, to give rest, refresh,...to lie down,...to make cool." The word is found in I Corinthians 16:18 to describe the help given to Paul. "I am glad of the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied. For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such." "The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain: But, when he was in Rome, he sought me out very diligently, and found me" (II Timothy 1:16-17). Paul gladly sacrificed and served the Lord (II Corinthians 12:15). In II Corinthians 11:23-33, we read of the dangers, pains, and false accusations that he faced. Verse 27 sums up some of Paul's trials. "In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness." God help all of us here at Crockett Rd. to be spirit refreshers. DAN
